Important information for the match at the Allianz Arena



FAN ITEMS - BANNERS - CHOREOGRAPHIES

FAN ITEMS

ALLOWED

- Three megaphones (under certain conditions*)
- Five (big) flags (length of the poles from 1.50 m.)
- Flags / two pole banners (length of the poles max. 1.50 m., plastic pole) – unlimited
- Drums (open at the bottom and visible – only in the away fan blocks!) – unlimited
- Fence flags (proper names) – unlimited (if space permits – fence flags in the upper tier must not be attached below the lower edge of the spit screen because of the boxes below)
- Photo cameras (digital, SLR), but only for private use – no professional equipment
- Official stadium bags

*

- Names of the users required beforehand (seven days before the match)
- Use only by the named people
- Person must be known personally in the fan blocks (away) and trustworthy regarding usage
- Participation in fan block talk no longer obligatory, but still encouraged (willingness to talk should be a matter of course)
- Use of megaphones only for support or announcements (e.g. keeping clear of the stairs), not for provocations to commit offences, insults or against actions by the police or public order office

PROHIBITED (non-exhaustive)

- Very large flags
- Camera tripods
- Pyrotechnical devices/fireworks of any kind
- Backpacks, fabric, plastic and gym bags larger than A4 size
- Liquids, metal or glass flasks
- Powerbanks and selfie sticks

BANNERS AND CHOREOGRAPHIES

must be authorised: Detailed registration (text, size, design, materials certificate etc.) in written form at least one week before the match. Fire safety regulations must be observed. More information on entrance controls on: <https://allianz-arena.com/en/matchday/entrance-controls>

ALLIANZ ARENA



STADIUM OPENS	Two hours before kick-off
ALCOHOL LIMIT	Entry may be refused to obviously drunken fans
ENTRANCE	<u>Only</u> via the new entrance for away fans (Entrance Guests) APPENDIX 1 Exception – wheelchair users: Car: parking at car park P1 – entrance via „Einlass Süd“ (South entrance) Bus: parking at coach park P Guests – entrance via „Einlass Nord“ (North entrance)
FAN PHOTOGRAPHER	Name required at least seven days before the match Needs a valid ticket and will get a bib to access the public areas/sections
ARENA CARD	https://allianz-arena.com/en/matchday/payment-systems-overview Arena Card return point for away fans on level 6 at the Arena Card service station, kiosk 29, between blocks 344 and 345
PAULANER-FAN-TREFFS	Only open for home fans for safety reasons
DRINKS CONTAINERS	Reuseable container system: €2 deposit with Arena Card



SUPPORTERS SECTION

BLOCKS	242 to 246 and 339 to 347 APPENDIX 2
TURNSTILES	In front of blocks 342, 343, 344 and 345
FOOD AND DRINKS	<p>Allowed in the blocks because of the spit screens.</p> <p>However, the spit screen cannot prevent the throwing of food and drinks into lower tiers, so please communicate the following information to your fans:</p> <p>If Fans of either your own team or Bayern fans are pelted with food and drinks we will be obliged to revoke this rule.</p>
FLAGS	<p><u>Flag constructions</u> by ultra groups in the upper tier are tolerated (spit screen).</p> <p>In case of abuse, for example regarding pyrotechnical devices, the fan items and objects (flag poles, tape, fence flags) will be prohibited.</p>
FENCE FLAGS	Fence flags in the upper tier must not be attached below the low edge of the spit screen because of the boxes below
SMOKING BAN	In all blocks
STAIRS	Must absolutely kept <u>free of obstructions</u> in all blocks

COACHES Parking at coach park P Guests (formerly Busparkplatz Nord) **APPENDIX 1**
Parking fee: €25
Opening coach park on matchdays: 10.00 CET

CARS Parking in the usual car parks (P1 to P3) until the completion of the new car park (P Guests) for away fans (end of year).
Parking fee: €10. Leaving P1 to P3: also possible by licence plate recognition, in addition to the Arena Card.

MINIVANS Vehicles greater than two metres in height, e.g. minivans, SUVs, etc. have to park on the coach park. The parking fee is €15.

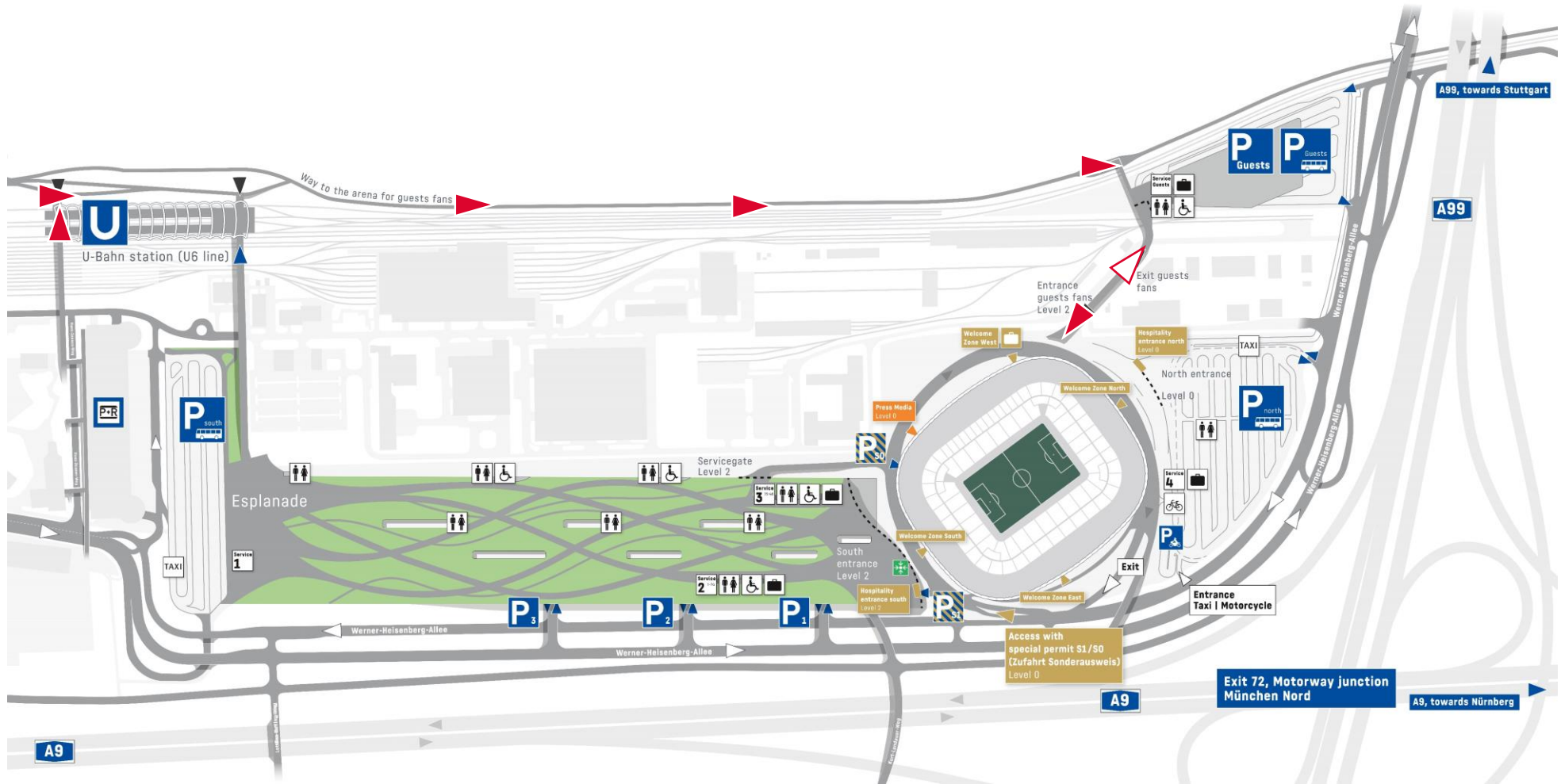
WHEELCHAIR USERS Cars parking only in the car park P1, level 3.
On matchday the first car park (P1-P3) is open from 08.00 CET. Please follow the traffic management signs!
Access for all wheelchair users, including away fans, at the South entrance (Entrance 1).

UNDERGROUND LINE Away fans travelling by underground line will no longer access the south entrance via the esplanade but will instead be led to the new entrance for guests fans via a footpath. **APPENDIX 1**
For departure, all visitors use the south esplanade (as usual) to get to the underground station.
