OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The protection and hygiene concept for events at the Allianz Arena is based on the „sixth Bavarian Infection Prevention Ordinance“ (6. BayIfSMV) as well as on the hygiene concept for cultural events and rehearsals (Hygienekonzept Kulturelle Veranstaltungen und Proben) and the hygiene concept for the catering sector (Hygienekonzept Gastronomie).

The seating plans and maximum capacities are adapted as necessary to comply with the latest official rules and regulations.

We are currently planning events with a maximum of 10 guests per row/table. A minimum distance of 1.5 meters is ensured between the backs of each chair.

PARTICIPANTS

Up to 200 people may gather at outdoor events without allocated and marked seating and up to 100 people are allowed to attend events in closed rooms inside the Arena.

Up to 400 people may gather at outdoor events with allocated and marked seating and up to 200 people are allowed to attend events in closed rooms inside the Arena.

HYGIENE MEASURES

The cleaning and disinfection intervals, in particular in corridors and restrooms, have been adapted.

Welcome Zones and restroom facilities, including contact areas, such as door handles and surfaces, are cleaned and disinfected every morning. The handrail on the escalator is disinfected every day. Additional disinfection stands are placed at the entrances (Welcome Zones).

We can organise further disinfection stands upon request.

MASK PROTECTION REQUIREMENT

Please note that masks must be worn in the Allianz Arena when entering and leaving the premises, as well as in the corridors, elevators, and restrooms. Participants must wear masks in closed rooms whenever they are not seating or not speaking in front of the audience.

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CLEANING

For all events in rooms at the Allianz Arena, cleaning prior to and after the event is mandatory. This includes cleaning the floors, restrooms, door handles, and table surfaces. Additional cleaning of the restrooms is also scheduled automatically during the lunch break. For large events, a dedicated staff person is automatically included in the package for any cleaning required during the event.

GUESTS

The event organizer is responsible for observing the registration obligation (participants by name). The organizer must provide a protection and hygiene concept and present it to the relevant district authority (Kreisverwaltungsbehörde) upon request. Anyone who has had contact with COVID-19 cases in the 14 days prior to the event, or anyone with fever or symptoms of an acute respiratory infection of any severity, is not permitted to visit the Allianz Arena.

EMPLOYEES

Our service staff wear masks and gloves to protect your guests and themselves. All members of staff have been trained and instructed in the relevant hygiene and contact reduction measures adopted as well as in the obligation to self-monitor and report any of the known COVID-19 symptoms. Handshakes and embraces are not permitted.

ROOM BOOKING

You can book rooms or enquire about room availability directly through DO & CO München. DO & CO is the full-service hospitality partner for organizing and providing catering for your event.

CATERING

The relevant regulations for the catering industry, including food hygiene requirements for operating in accordance with the hazard analysis and critical control points guidelines, or HACCP, are implemented. The company's internal processes have been adapted and contact with guests has been reduced to the bare minimum. Self-service is only available with packaged products and buffets are only possible if the food is served by staff behind glass partitions. Crockery and cutlery are prepared and packaged for each person.

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PARKING

Parking in the S0/S1 multistorey of the Allianz Arena is reserved for event guests. Up to 900 cars can park in the S1 multistorey on four levels. The S0 multistorey is available to box customers. Please let us know how many guests will be arriving by car. We will be happy to register you under your company name at the special vehicle access to grant you special access to the parking areas.

SIGNAGE

Notices related to the rules of conduct currently applicable are posted at all relevant places and entrances.

USE OF ELEVATORS

Masks must be worn in the elevator lobbies or elevators and there must be no more than two people in the elevator lobbies or elevators at any time. The stairs can be used as an alternative.

RESTROOM FACILITIES

Masks must be worn in the restroom areas and access to these areas is restricted to two people at any time. Washing facilities, liquid soap, disposable towels, and disinfectant are available in all restrooms. Infographics on hand hygiene are displayed in the restrooms.

VENTILATION

The entrance or exit door of the rooms is always open during event setup and teardown. The stadium company's ventilation system is programmed for a maximum air exchange rate. All rooms are supplied with fresh air. No air is "reused".

GUIDANCE

For an organised guidance we will work with separated entrance and exit if possible. Barriers as well as distance and floor markings are used for additional safety.
